Woodridge Man Arrested for Criminal Trespass to a Residence and Criminal Damage to Property

- Jose Hernandez, 29, charged with two crimes related to an incident in the morning of 9/11/17
- Hernandez illegally entered a private residence through a window feet-first & a resident called police
- Officers arrested Hernandez without incident

Woodridge, Ill. – On Monday, September 11, 2017 Woodridge Police Department officers arrested Jose Hernandez, age 29, of the 2400 block of Forest Drive, Woodridge, Ill. for Criminal Trespass to Residence (felony) and Criminal Damage to Property at a home in the 7600 block of Deerfield Avenue.

The incident occurred at 3:22 a.m. when a Woodridge resident heard unfamiliar sounds and woke up to investigate the source of the noise. The resident then observed an unknown male entering the residence through a window feet-first. The resident detained Hernandez and called the police. Upon arrival, officers arrested Hernandez without incident. Officers transported Hernandez to the DuPage County Jail.
