#### ITEM HISTORY:

In 2011 the Village hired James J. Benes and Associates to perform a Village-wide roadway and bicycle path pavement analysis and provide an updated pavement maintenance plan. Benes recommended that the Village continue to perform curb line crack filling as soon as possible after a roadway resurfacing and to continue to perform random crack fill on streets that have minor cracking at the surface. Benes also recommended that the Village crack fill bike paths prior to seal coating bike paths. Village staff has been following these recommendations since 2012.

On August 6, 2013 the bids for the 2013 Crack Fill and Seal Coat Project were opened. The sole bidder, Behm Pavement Maintenance, Inc., was responsive and met the project specifications.

#### ITEM DISCUSSION:

The bid from Behm Pavement Maintenance, Inc., the sole bidder, came in higher than the budgeted amount for this project. Therefore, in order to meet budget, pursuant to section II.I of the Project Specifications, staff recommends moving forward with only the roadway crack filling portion of the project, and deleting the bike path crack filling, bike path seal coating and bike path patching portions of the work from this contract. The bike path work will need to be re-budgeted in next year's 2014 Stub Year Capital Budget.

Behm Pavement Maintenance, Inc. provided references that spoke highly of the company. Additionally, Behm has completed several crack sealing projects for the Village in the past and always did an excellent job. Behm is also an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Prequalified Contractor.

It is Public Works recommendation to award a contract to Behm Pavement Maintenance, Inc. for the 2013 Crack Fill and Seal Coat Project in the amount of \$90,847.62 for the roadway crack sealing portion of the project. In the past this project was typically funded through the Village's MFT Fund. In order to fund additional road maintenance projects out of the MFT Fund, this project is now funded through the General Fund. The FY 2014 budget for this project is \$89,686. The \$1,161.62 budget shortfall for this project will come from other programmed expenses in the same line item (101-3440-431.30-38).
