Public Works has reviewed the bids that were received in response to Bid #2014-03. A total of four (4) bids were received. The bid requested pricing for the 63<sup>rd</sup> Street Storm Sewer Inlet Improvement Project. The lowest bid in the amount of \$67,860 was received from Copenhaver Construction Inc.

The Village Engineer's estimate for the project was approximately \$70,000. This project was advanced from the Five Year Budget to Stub Year 2014 after the storm events of May 2014 that caused heavy roadway flooding. The Storm Water Budget has \$62,000 budgeted in SY2014 and \$357,500 budgeted in CY2015. Though the SY2014 capital costs are anticipated to be fully expensed, one or more of the CY2015 projects will likely be tied to outside funding or permitting causing the expense to move out beyond the current 20 month capital project window.

This project entails the removal and replacement of revised storm inlets on 63<sup>rd</sup> Street aimed at allowing a higher volume of storm water to enter the storm system to aid in reducing the area and duration of street flooding. This area is in a floodplain so at times when Prentiss Creek backs up this low area will still result in flooding consistent to the event flood elevation.

Although staff has not had prior experience working with Copenhaver Construction Inc., staff did call references on the company including the City of Wheaton (\$1,975,810.00: Bridge Construction project including bridge, concrete walls, pile driving and related work) and the

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Illinois Department of Transportation (Project 63655, \$3,038,107: Widening and reconstruction of Edgewood Drive and Storm Water work; Project 601109, \$2,600,000: Installation of Railroad Embankment). IDOT reported Copenhaver Construction, Inc. to be efficient, responsive, and on budget with very few change orders. IDOT noted that their Superintendent was very good and the company does really good underground work.

Public Works is recommending the Village Board award of Bid 2014-03 to Copenhaver Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$67,860.
